The reality is that many fleet issues do not appear overnight. They develop gradually and can often be identified through effective inspection and reporting processes.

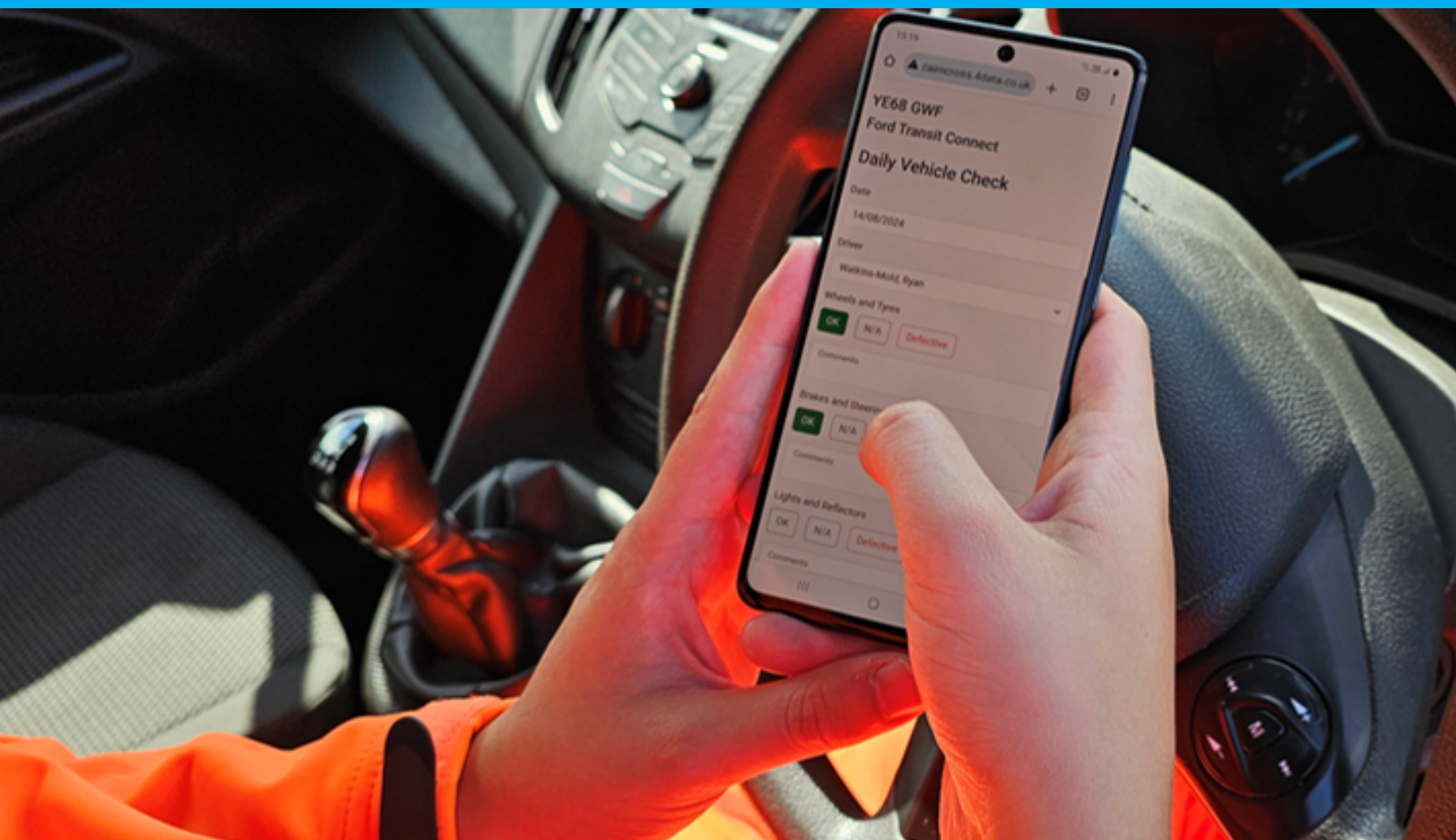


PREVENTION IS ALWAYS CHEAPER THAN REPAIR

By implementing robust daily vehicle checks and ensuring defects are reported as soon as they are identified, operators can move from reactive maintenance to proactive fleet management.



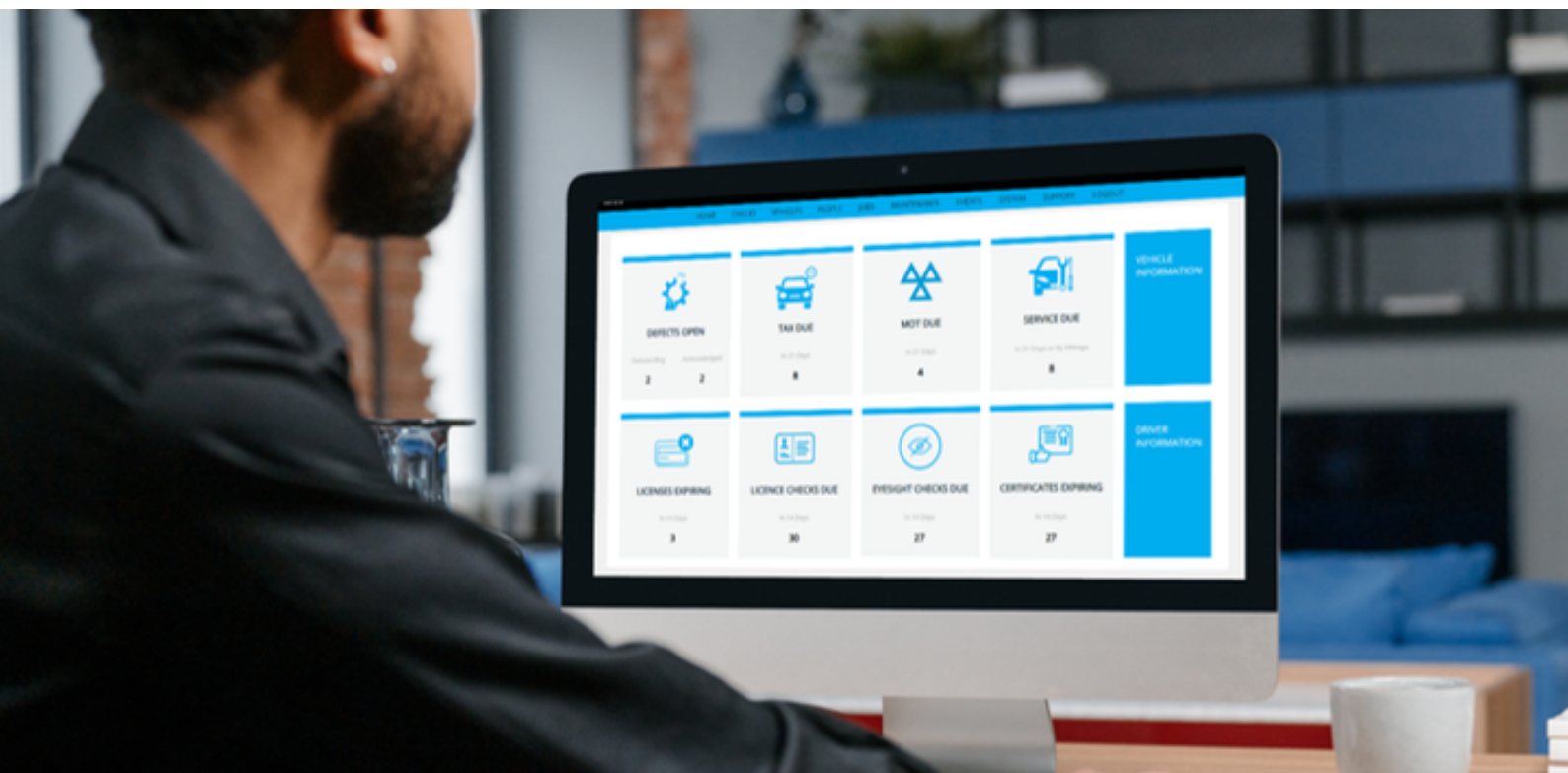
VISIBILITY CREATES ACCOUNTABILITY

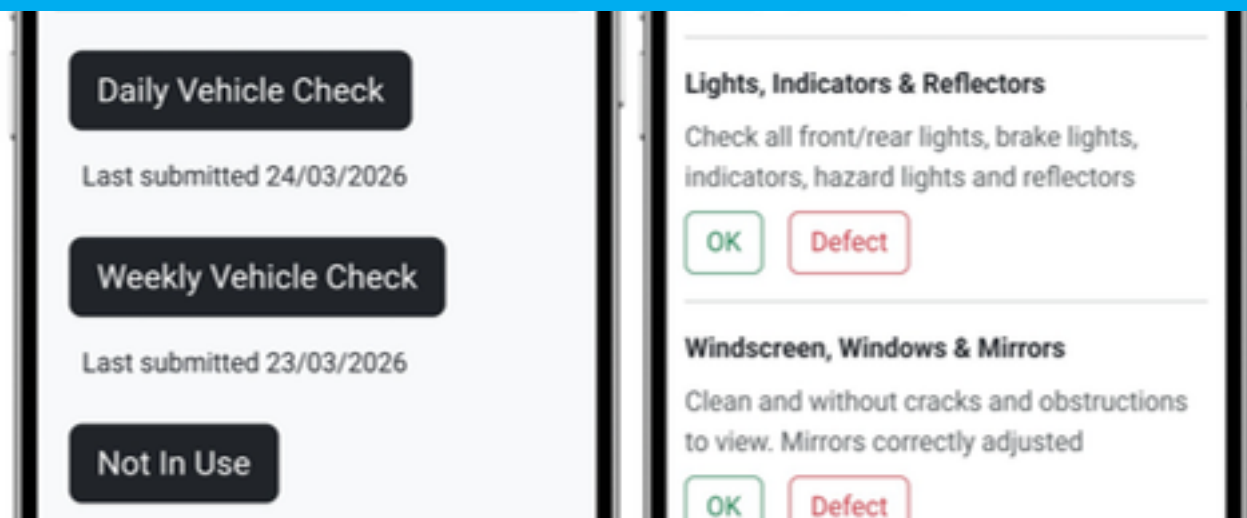

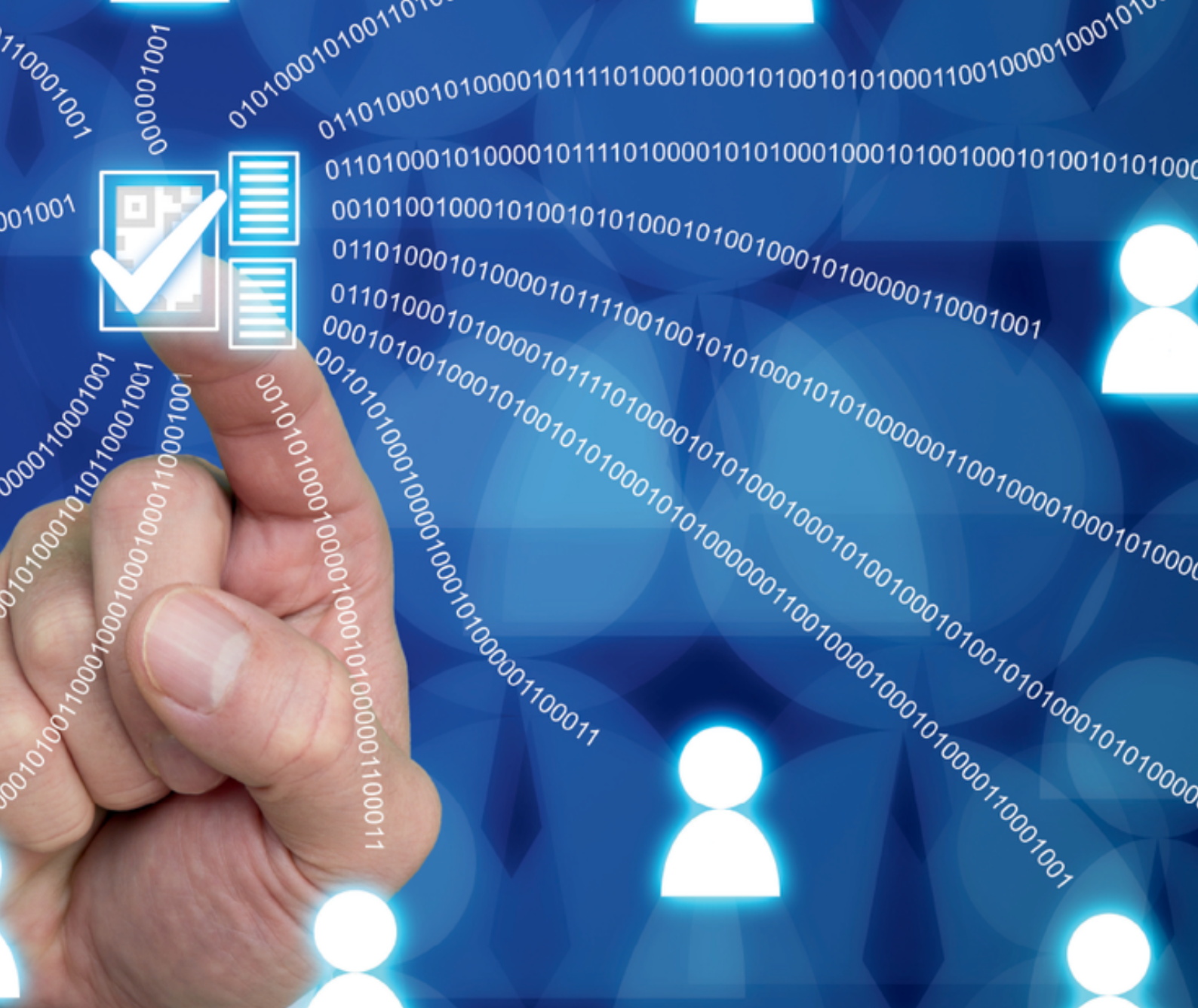
